Name of Work: Master System Integrator for Implementation of Integrated Smart Solutions at Patna under Smart City Mission in Patna.



- 1. At the outset the Managing Director welcomed all the members of the Tender Committee.
- 2. The Tender Committee noted that till the stipulated date and time of submission of online bids i.e., 16:00 hours on 14.07.2021, as indicated in NIT dated 16.04.2021; 4 (four) bids from following bidders were uploaded on the e-procurement website:
 - i. M/s Webel Technology Limited, West Bengal
 - ii. M/s Bharat Electronics Limited, Uttarakhand.
 - iii. M/s Larsen & Toubro Limited, Chennai
 - iv. M/s NEC Corporation India Private Ltd., New Delhi & M/s Niveshan Technologies India Pvt. Ltd. (JV), Gurugram.
- 3. Further, the Committee noted that only after the successful verification of EMDs through the respective banks, the bids were downloaded from the e-procurement website; that too after the due date and time of opening of technical bids.
- 4. Thereafter, the Evaluation Sheet containing Pre-qualification criteria in respect of all the four bids, received in response to the NIT No 05/MD/PSCL/2021-22 dated 16.04.2021, floated by PSCL, was prepared by the specially constituted Evaluation Committee, vide PSCL Office Order No. 2839 dated 07.09.2020.
- 5. The Tender Committee went through the Pre-qualification criteria Evaluation Sheet made by the aforementioned Committee and agreed with the same. The Tender Committee declares M/s Webel Technology Limited, West Bengal non-responsive for non fulfilment of the following pre-qualification criteria mentioned against their names in the Table on the succeeding page:

Clause 3.5 (S.No.8): Bidder (Lead Bidder or Any Consortium Partner) should have experience in implementation and maintenance of following project of value not less than cumulative value of INR 20 Crore for any of the following: a) ATCS or b) Command & Control Centre / Network Operations Centre (NOC) or c) Surveillance command centre or d) ITMS (ANPR/RLVD/SVD/ E-challan/VMS) or h) Environmental Sensors or f) PA/ Passenger Information system / ECB In India or abroad in last 5 years. Note: Bidder can propose separate (one or more) projects for each component for evaluation.	Out of the 23 projects whose details have been submitted, none falls under the criteria mentioned in RFP viz. - 7. The Tender Committee recommends uploading of these proceedings on the website, giving time upto 15:00 hours on 18.08.2021, for receiving online objections and claims, if any. The Committee also recommends evaluation of technical bids of bidders who succeeded in Stage 1: Pre-Qualification, if no objection or claim is received till the due date.
